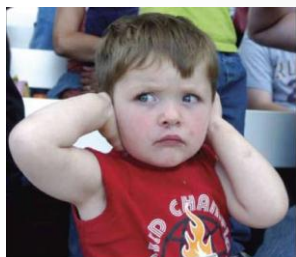
A message from Steve Harris, Chief Steward

### Practice/Qualifying/Race

We will be running this event according to the 2011 GCR and the 2011 Penalty Guidelines included in your Driver's packet. Please familiarize yourself with both

## The Don't Do List



### Passing Under Yellow

All "PUY" incidents will be investigated and appropriate penalties will be enforced.

### Tradin' Paint

In SCCA, we do not appreciate contact. All metal to metal incidents will be investigated and damage noted in your logbook. Also, some nice folks called the "Stewards of the Meeting" may want to critique your driving habits if you are involved in contact.

### Jump Start

Don't lose your finish by jumping the start! Jumped starts may receive a "Stop and Go" penalty or position penalty at the end of the race.

### Impound – Don't miss it!

The Top 3 finishers in class must go directly to impound. If you even think you are top 3, go to impound. Don't risk a DQ by not showing up.
